The Sign of Jonas

The *Sign of Jonah* is a journey through Lent to the Feast of Easter. The *Sign of Jonah* is often understood in relation to the sacrament of Baptism: as St Paul wrote:

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.  
(Romans 6. 3,4)
